

SOCIAL FORESTRY AND CLIMATE CHANGE RISK MANAGEMENT

Protecting the environment and keeping the environment clean is very important for development of any country. The environment is the habitat and resource of all living things. Excessive use of natural resources is destroying the environment. Deforestation, land degradation, natural disasters, greenhouse effect, cyclone are the most common causes of human habitation. Poor people have more problems as a result of environmental degradation. Excessive use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides has reduced soil fertility. Poor people owning small plots of land are suffering the most. Due to the residual position of pesticides in food, various unknown diseases are being caused in the human body. PROSHIKA is conducting this program with the aim of changing such life threatening conditions and mitigating the effects of climate change. The activities of this program are: a) Social forestry / roadside forestry b) Nursery development, awareness raising training and c) Maintain communication with government agencies. In the financial year 2020-2021, the program has earned 3 lakh 45 thousand taka by selling trees from the tree planting project. A total of 45 people benefited from it. A plan has been made plan to earn 1 crore 20 lakh taka in the next financial year.
